Xcel customers likely to see higher bills

Xcel Energy customers in Colorado will likely see a 15 percent increase in monthly electricity bills from April 1 through June 30 because of higher natural gas prices, partly the result of more gas being shipped out through the new Rockies Express pipeline.

If approved, a typical residential customer's electricity bill will rise \$8.53 next month to \$65.02. A typical small-business customer's electricity bill will increase by \$13.96 to \$104.26.
